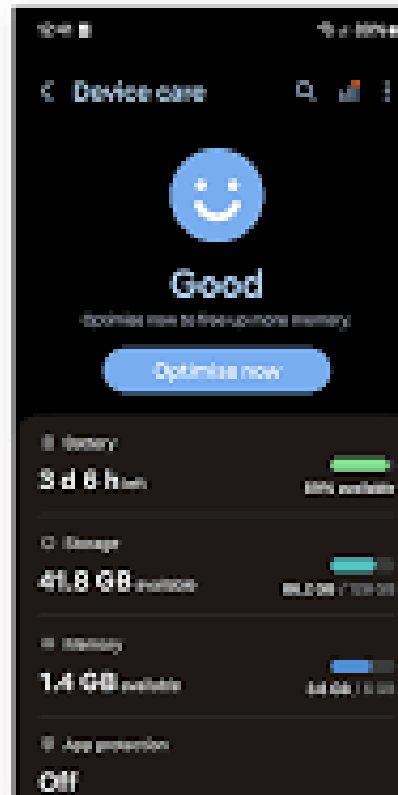

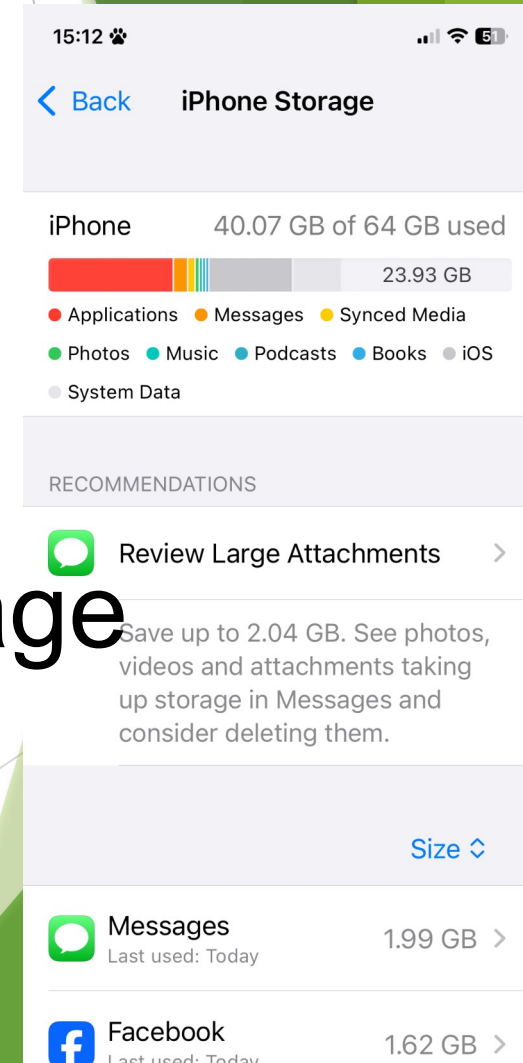

# De-Clutter Your Home Screen

Choose Home Screen Layout and  
delete unused apps

1. Settings
2. Home Screen
3. Layout and Grid
4. Uninstall Apps



1. Long press any app  
on the screen and  
choose Edit Home  
Screen





# Improve Phone Security

Use Biometrics to Lock Screen and  
Disable Swipe Down for Notification

1. Settings
2. Notifications
3. Swipe down for notification panel



1. Settings
2. Notifications
3. Show Previews
4. Choose "When unlocked"





# How to Use The App Store

## Use App Store to download Apps

1. Google Play Store
2. Galaxy Store
3. or your phone's App Store



1. App Store is an app on the home screen

# IOS 18

An Iphone 12.  
This is the oldest Iphone  
that can still be upgraded to  
the latest IOS18. This latest  
operating system is the  
most secure and  
recommended as a  
minimum by HCC



# When upgrading to the latest IOS 18

- The interface may look different
- A newer phone may not have the same buttons and controls as your old one
- Sometimes there is a way to get it looking like the old way. Or add an onscreen button for the ones you loved



# Personalisation of the screen

By personalising the screen, the more familiar it looks, the more you realise how easy it is to get to the things you do most

# How much battery have I got left?

Add a percentage icon to the top of your screen

This is done via Settings...

1. Settings
2. Battery
3. Battery Percentage

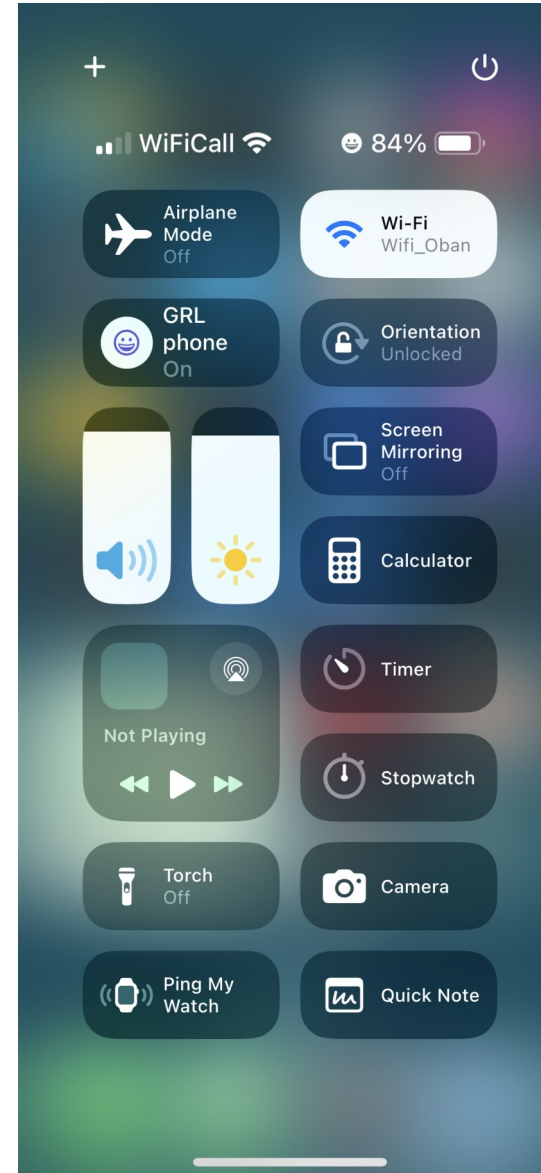


# The Control Center is a good area in IOS 18



OR THIS...

You swipe  
down towards  
the middle of  
the screen from  
the top right to  
get to Control  
Center

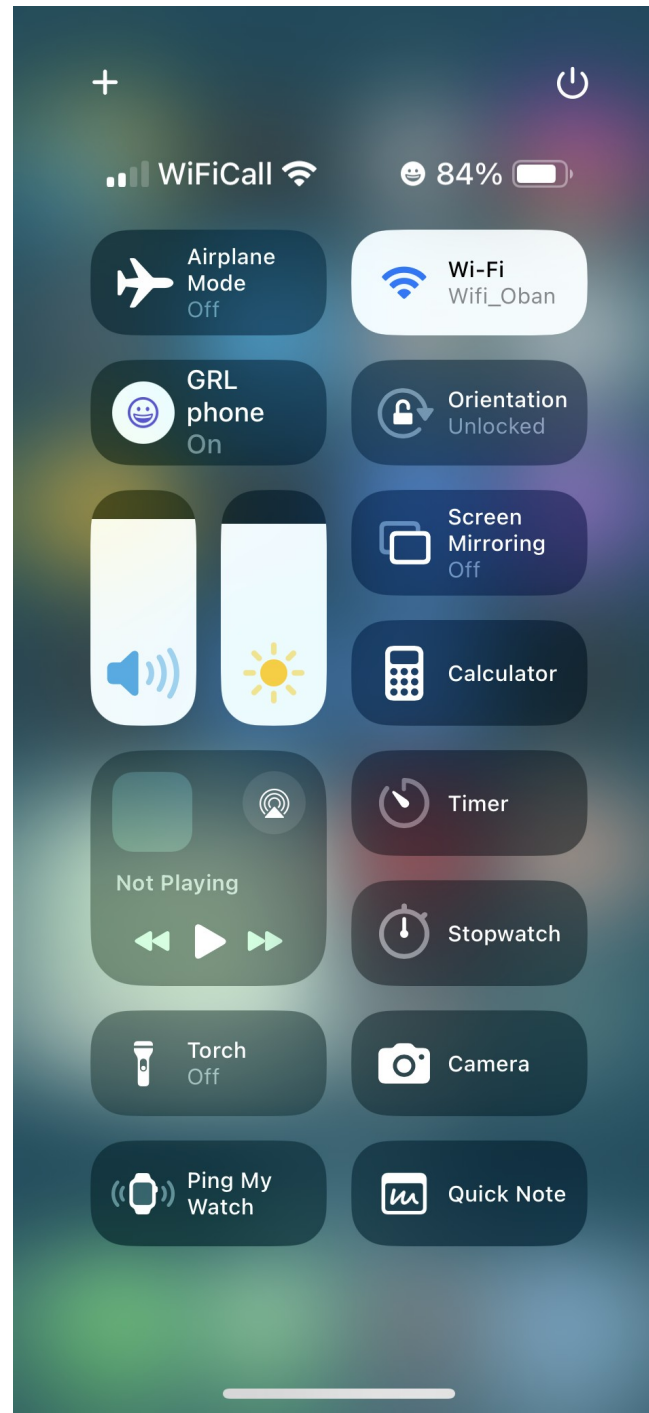




So now, mine looks like this:

Make the “icons” two cells wide and you get a description

Get rid of the ones you don't use and have the ones you want most

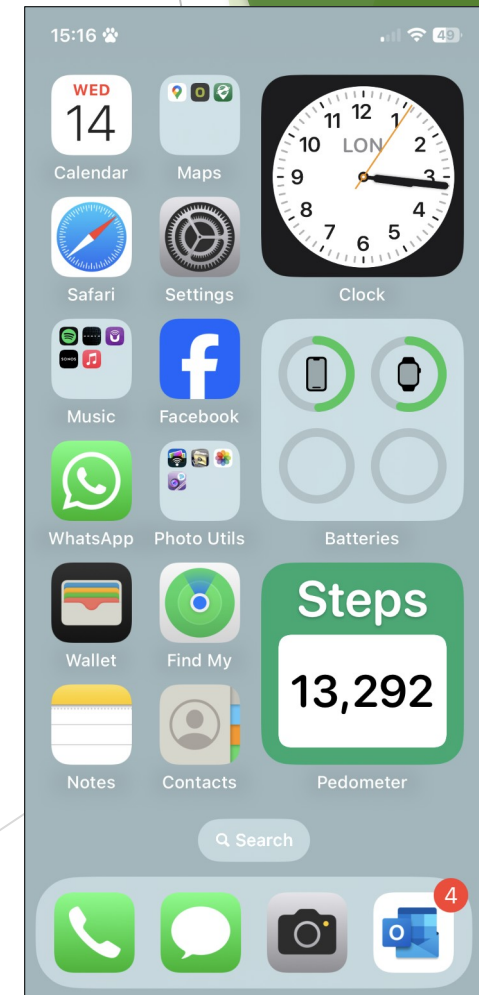




# Control Center – a useful set of resources

Many useful things to use regularly, like:

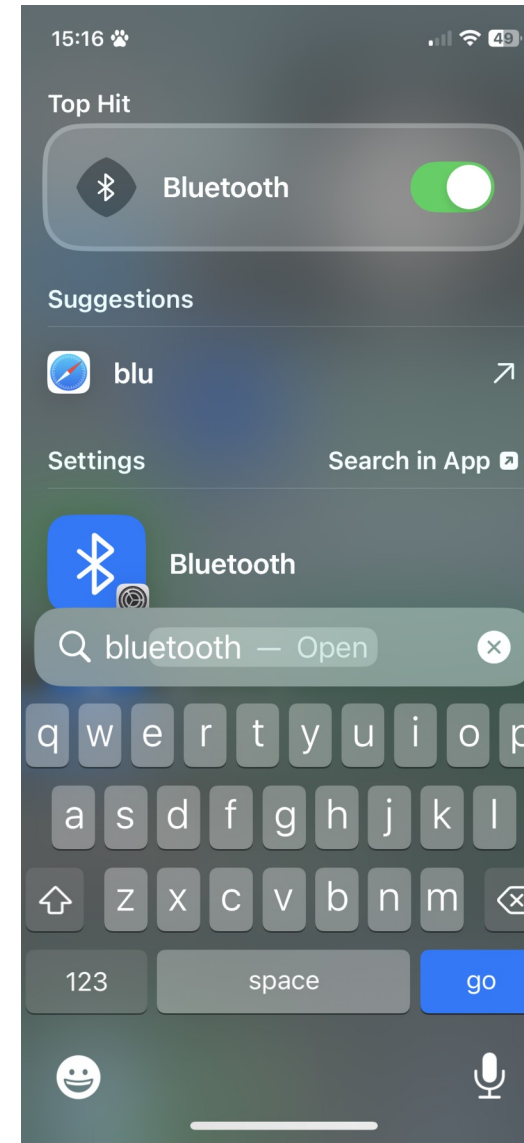
- Turn on/off
- Airplane mode when travelling
- Turn the volume up





## Using Spotlight search

- Search for Apps
- Search for Settings
- Turn Bluetooth on/off
- Turn Data on/off
